**A NEW LOOK FOR SHIPYARD**

***Shipyards Golf Club Completes its Bunker, Greens and Clubhouse Renovations***

Hilton Head Island, SC – Shipyards Golf Club is celebrating a course makeover this holiday weekend. The club has recently completed their summer renovation projects including new bunkers and green surfaces on the Clipper and Galleon courses which complement the clubhouse facelift this past spring.

Featuring stunning white sand bunkers and new Diamond Zoysia greens, Shipyards is poised for new chapter in its history. From its original design fifteen years ago, the course is once again a leader in South Carolina golf. The course is the first club in the state to introduce this surface which is expected to improve year-round playing conditions.

In conjunction with the course improvements, the Shipyards Clubhouse has also completed its renovations. Improvements include new carpet, tile and paint throughout the clubhouse, new furniture and granite countertops in the restaurant, and new doors, lighting and fixtures throughout. Earlier improvements included outside fans and flat screen TV's in the outside covered patio area – creating an inviting setting for relaxing in the open air after a round of golf or for catching up with friends and family.
